

What Can I Expect During My Bite of Glamour Portrait Mini-Session?

Your mini-session during the Bite of Glamour evening is a taste of what we can do. It will be 15 minutes, so you want to be prepared.

Think ahead of time about the "look" you want to achieve in your portrait. It's fine to bring tear sheets from magazines that suggest poses you like.

Choose one outfit, with variations that can be added or removed quickly in the camera room.

There will be no pressure to reveal anything more than your personality. You can be as modest or daring as you wish and you will always be portrayed as a lady and nothing else.

If you come to Bite of Glamour with a friend, she may assist you with your hair, posing, props and clothing if you wish.

The key to glamorous portraits is your comfort and enjoyment. Your mood and emotions will come through in your portraits. If you are having a good time, you'll love your portraits.

Selecting Your Favorites

When the photography is complete, we will review your session images and you can choose the poses you would like to include in your collection. You'll make your choices during a separate viewing and purchasing appointment in the studio the week after the event.

The poses you choose will be enhanced to help you look your glamorous best.

Sunburn

Avoid the sun (in January in Bellingham, you've gotta be kidding) and tanning booths prior to your portrait session. A little sun looks good, but we can't take the red out of a sunburn.

Hair

If you are going to get your hair cut and styled prior to your portrait session try to schedule the session the day of the photo session. Pamper yourself with a makeover and we'll photograph you at your glamorous best with your professionally done hair and makeup. The hair stylist at Bite of Glamour will touch up your style to look its best for the camera.

Sense of Humor

Your portrait session will be comfortable, relaxed, informal and fun. We'll talk, we'll laugh and we'll capture in your portraits who you are. So bring your sense of humor along above all else.

Make-Up

Keep your make up natural and bring it along for those necessary touch ups. Powder is essential to keep your skin looking smooth and beautiful so bring some along. Consider getting a professional makeover prior to your session. If you're not sure what to choose, Roxane will have some great Mary Kay cosmetics to enhance your look.

Footwear

High heels and stockings are always appropriate for glamorous portraits. Bring footwear to match your outfit. Don't forget stockings or socks appropriate to your outfits and footwear. Barefoot can be good, too.

Jewelry

Bring necklaces, rings, bracelets, earrings and other jewelry to fit your outfits and your personality. It's better to bring something and not use it than to wish you had brought it.

Props

Bring hats, musical instruments, sports equipment and uniforms, sunglasses, hobby items, stuffed animals and anything else that says, "This is me!"

We'll have some feather boas, a couple of Mardi Gras masks, and some elegant wraps at the studio that you can try.

Glasses

We do our best to avoid any glare from your glasses, but sometimes that just isn't possible. To be assured of no glare, please have your lenses removed from your eyeglasses for your portrait session or pick up a matching empty frame from your eyeglass provider.

Clothing

If you're going to include revealing poses, wear loose fitting clothes and underthings to the portrait session so there are no strap marks or lines.

A V-neck is more slimming and flattering than a rounded collar. Darker colors are also slimming.
